Retired Bishop Ricardo Ramírez of Las Cruces, NM was the first bishop of the Las Cruces Diocese, which was established in 1982. He was born in Bay City, TX. Both his parents and their families were migrant workers in southern Texas. He attended public schools in Bay City and graduated from the University of St. Thomas in Houston, in 1959. He was ordained a priest in 1966 as a member of the Basilian Fathers. Bishop Ramírez served in parishes in Canada, Detroit and Mexico. He was on the staff of the Mexican-American Cultural Center in San Antonio when he was appointed auxiliary bishop of San Antonio in 1981. He is the author of a book *Power from the Margins*.
