The Catechism of the Catholic Church begins to speak of the first commandment in these words: "The first commandment embraces faith, hope, and charity. When we say "God" we confess a constant, unchangeable being, always the same, faithful and just, without any evil. It follows that we must necessarily accept his words and have complete faith in him and acknowledge his authority. He is almighty, merciful, and infinitely beneficent... Who could not place all hope in him? Who could not love him when contemplating the treasures of goodness and love he has poured out on us?" (CCC # 2086).

Notice the reference here to faith, hope and love. These virtues are presented as the correct response to God's revelation and love in our life. These virtues are seen as a way of honoring God and putting him first in our lives. We will now look a little deeper into these three virtues of Faith, Hope, and Charity to see how they fulfill this first commandment.

Lenten Regulations

We remind you of the obligations for this Season of Lent. First, we are asked to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on every Friday of Lent. This obligation exists for everyone over the age of 14 years old. In addition, on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, we are asked to fast. This fast means that we are allowed to eat two small meals, (which together would not add up to a normal sized meal), and then one full meal. This obligation to fast exists for all Catholics ages 15 to 59. However, the Bishops remind us,

"THOSE THAT ARE EXCUSED FROM FAST AND ABSTINENCE OUTSIDE THE AGE LIMITS INCLUDE THE PHYSICALLY OR MENTALLY ILL INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS SUFFERING FROM CHRONIC ILLNESSES SUCH AS DIABETES. ALSO EXCLUDED ARE PREGNANT OR NURSING WOMEN. IN ALL CASES, COMMON SENSE SHOULD PREVAIL, AND ILL PERSONS SHOULD NOT FURTHER JEOPARDIZE THEIR HEALTH BY FASTING."


It's Easter Basket Blessing Time!


An icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be the centerpiece of a special Sacred Heart Holy Hour at Our Lady of the Desert Church at 5PM on Friday, April 4, 2025. The holy hour, flowing from the jubilee for the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (Dec. 27, 2023 – Jun. 27, 2025) and inspired by Pope Francis' encyclical letter Dilexit Nos (He Loved Us), is sponsored by Knights of Columbus (Our Lady of the Desert Council 15704). During the holy hour, an icon depicting the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome, will be displayed. This reproduction of the original image bears the blessing of Pope Francis and is one of more than 300 icons traveling across the world as part of the Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon Program. Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly has said that as Knights bring these icons across the world to their parishes, he

hopes "they will invite their families — and all families — to consecrate their homes and themselves to the Sacred Heart." He further said that "In the heart of Christ, we see the heart of the Father. And we ask Our Lord to help us make his heart our own, so that we may see and love in others what he sees and loves in us." The Sacred Heart Holy Hour will include readings from Sacred Scripture and reflections from Pope Francis on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, as well as the Divine Mercy Chaplet, prayers to the Sacred Heart, and time for silent prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The prayer service will lead all present to grow in their love of God and devotion to his Most Sacred Heart. Please Spread the Word, everyone is welcome.

Please join us in congratulating our 'Family of the Month' - the Francis, Bob and Chris.





Dear Padre,

May I receive Communion if I'm divorced and haven't gotten an annulment?

Yes, you may. Divorce, in itself, is not an impediment to the reception of Communion. Divorce, although regrettable because of the many ramifications that may be part of the experience, is not in itself a sin. There are situations when divorce may be the most loving choice and make it possible for all parties involved to live the lives God is calling them to live.

Remarriage, when a person is not free to marry because of the presence of a previous bond, is an impediment to the reception of holy Communion. Although this situation is more and more common, it does not mean that the law of the Church, representative of the teaching of Jesus, can be set aside. As part of the process of healing from your



divorce and moving on with your life, you may want to seek an annulment, particularly if you think you might want to marry again. The annulment process can often be healing and a source of great blessing. It also provides a rare opportunity to reflect on what was lost as a result of the original divorce and what can be learned as a way of moving forward and building a second marriage that is strong and life-giving. •
